

GREEN Program Student Grant Information

Through the Kleinman Center for Energy Policy's Student Grant Program, eligible Penn students can apply for up to \$1,000 towards their program fee.

The GREEN Program offers short (8-10 day) educational travel opportunities to Iceland, Peru, Nepal, and Japan, each with a unique itinerary exploring energy and environmental challenges specific to the location. Trips run throughout the year during winter, spring, and summer breaks. Program fees range from \$3,200 to \$4,700, not including airfare.

The GREEN Program is not affiliated with, nor managed by, the University of Pennsylvania. Some students in the College of Engineering may be eligible to receive course credit. They must receive XCAT approval prior to enrolling and they can reach out to Sonya Gwak at sgwak@seas.upenn.edu for more information.

Apply for a GREEN Program Grant

Please review relevant application deadlines and eligible trip dates on the following page. Funding is subject to availability. Awards are paid directly to the GREEN Program after all requirements below have been met. Students must:

- Meet all Kleinman Center student grant requirements.
- Be enrolled at least part-time in an undergraduate or graduate degree program at the University of Pennsylvania *at the time of the trip*.
- Be accepted to a GREEN Program trip **before** applying for a grant.
- Attend a trip that meets the date eligibility requirements for the grant period (see table on the next page) AND
- Submit a deposit to the GREEN Program **at least 10 weeks prior to program start date**. Please review eligible trip dates and associated deposit deadlines for upcoming grant periods on the next page.
- International travel related to a Kleinman Center grant must be registered with Penn's International Travel Registry, My Trips:

- Awards announced by: 10/15
- If a grant is awarded: students have two weeks to accept funding by returning a signed award letter
- Award payment will not be issued until the GREEN Program has received a trip deposit. Students must submit their deposit by the dates listed below:
