## INFORMATION NOTE

Call for Inputs by the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures

The COP, CMP and CMA by its decision 4/COP.25, 4/CMP.15 and 4/CMA.2 mandated the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) to receive input from experts, practitioners and relevant organizations in order to implement some activities in its workplan. Two activities which are to be considered for implementation by KCI at its third meeting using this modality are:

- Exploring approaches to inform the development and implementation of climate change mitigation strategies, plans, policies and programmes that maximize the positive and minimize the negative impacts of response measures;
- Enhancing the capacity and understanding of Parties, through collaboration and input from stakeholders, on the assessment and analysis of the impacts of the implementation of response measures to facilitate the undertaking of economic diversification and transformation and just transition.

The KCI invites experts, practitioners and organizations to submit their inputs with respect to above activities on:

- Potential knowledge products and case studies related to the two activities that could inform the work of the KCI;
- Potential stakeholders that could collaborate with the KCI on implementing these two activities.
