MESSAGE TO PARTIES AND OBSERVERS

Call for Inputs by the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures

The COP, CMP and CMA by its decision 4/COP.25, 4/CMP.15 and 4/CMA.2 mandated the Katowice Committee of Experts on the Impacts of the Implementation of Response Measures (KCI) to receive input from experts, practitioners and relevant organizations in order to implement some activities in its workplan.

The KCI invites inputs with respect to activity "identify country-driven strategies and best practices on just transition of the workforce and creation of decent work and quality jobs and on economic diversification and transformation focusing on challenges and opportunities from the implementation of low greenhouse gas emission policies and strategies towards the achievement of sustainable development"

The KCI invites submission to provide concrete examples and best practices on:

- (a) Just transition of the work force and creation of decent work and quality jobs;
- (b) Economic diversification and transformation.

In making submissions, **respondents are encouraged to use the outline** described in chapter 2 and 3 of annex V of the <u>KCI 4 meeting report</u>¹, for each example while making submission.

Distribution: To Parties and observer States to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change through their national focal points and diplomatic missions accredited to the Federal Republic of Germany, United Nations Secretariat units and bodies, specialized agencies and related organizations, as well as intergovernmental and non-governmental organizations admitted as observers by the Conference of the Parties.

Key characteristic of the example may include strategy's/policy's geographical coverage, sector coverage, implementation process including assessment of impacts of policy if done. The example should focus on challenges and opportunities encountered while implementing low greenhouse gas emission policies and strategies towards the achievement of sustainable development that have led to country-driven strategies and best practices on just transition of the workforce and creation of decent work and quality jobs and on economic diversification and transformation.
