

## GREEN Program Student Grant Information

Through the Kleinman Center for Energy Policy's Student Grant Program, eligible Penn students can apply for up to \$1,000 towards their program fee for trips to Iceland, Nepal, and Japan. Other trips are not eligible.

The GREEN Program offers short (8-10 day) educational travel opportunities to Iceland, Nepal, Japan, and several other countries. Each opportunity offers a unique itinerary exploring energy and environmental challenges specific to the location. Trips run throughout the year during winter, spring, and summer breaks. Program fees range from \$3,200 to \$4,700, not including airfare.

The GREEN Program is not affiliated with, nor managed by, the University of Pennsylvania.

### **Apply for a GREEN Program Grant**

*Please review relevant application deadlines and eligible trip dates on the GREEN Program's website.* Grant funding is subject to availability. Awards are paid directly to the GREEN Program after all requirements below have been met. Students must:

- Meet all Kleinman Center [student grant requirements](#).
- Be enrolled at least part-time in an undergraduate or graduate degree program at the University of Pennsylvania *at the time of the trip*.
- Be accepted to a GREEN Program trip **before** applying for a grant.
- Attend a trip that departs no less than 12 weeks from the grant deadline.

**Please note:** the Kleinman Center will review all grant applications after the application deadline. We cannot review early applications. Trips departing less than 12 weeks from the grant application deadline are not eligible for funding.

### **If a grant is awarded, students must:**

- Accept funding within 2 weeks by returning a signed award letter
- Submit a deposit to the GREEN Program **at least 10 weeks prior to program start date**.
- Submit a 600-word summary of their GREEN program capstone project within **1 year** of receiving funding.
- International travel related to a Kleinman Center grant must be registered with Penn's International Travel Registry, My Trips:
