As the chair of the Subsidiary Body for Implementation (SBI), I have been tasked by decision 1/CMA.5, para 182, to hold an expert dialogue on children and climate change to discuss the disproportionate impacts of climate change on children, and relevant policy solutions in this regard.

The dialogue is mandated to be organised during the sixtieth session of the Subsidiary Bodies to be held in Bonn, Germany from 3 to 13 June 2024. The agenda for the expert dialogue will be shared in due course.
